17 The X card is placed under the cards, where each one can easily grasp it.	18 If there is a card or answer that you do not want to include in the story, touch the X card. This content is removed from the game.	19 If your card is removed from the game in this way, draw a new one. You can use the X card on your own card.	20 Your turn, you can pass. Give your card to the next player and say, "I'd like to hear your answer to that question.
